Essay Question

In keeping with the theme for vocations, "**Bringing Christ to Others**", choose one of the following prompts:

<u>"How could my family's life foster and encourage a positive response to</u> <u>God's call to a religious vocation?"</u>

<u>"Imagine yourself for a moment as a priest, deacon or religious sister or brother.</u> How would you spend your day?"

You are strongly encouraged to interview a priest or religious and write about what you learned from your interview.

Length and Appearance: Essays should be about 200 to 300 words in length and typed in a standard black typeface and doubled spaced. Only one essay per student may be submitted.

Eligibility and Sponsors: The contest is open to all students in Grades 7 and 8 who live in or attend school within the Archdiocese of Louisville, or who are participating in religious education or youth ministry classes. Religion teachers, catechists, and youth ministers at each parish or school may serve as a sponsor for each student who submits an essay. Sponsors should review the student's essay before submission to ensure that it meets essay guidelines.

Contest Dates: The Vocations Essay Contest begins on November 1, 2020 and ends January 8, 2021. Winners will be announced shortly after February 5, 2021.

Judging: All submitted essays will be read and judged by a committee selected by the Vocations Office. Essays will be judged upon: a) How well it answers the question; b) Originality; c) Grammar, readability and neatness.

Prizes and Recognition:

1 st place	\$100	plus certificate
2 nd place	\$75	plus certificate
3 rd place	\$50	plus certificate

Information will be sent to winners soon after the contest ends.
