 - The Arts and Environment Committee re-did the Lenten banners and are fixing the Holy Thursday banners. The team is ordering flowers for Easter.
 - Alter Servers are being brought back. There will be training for Alter Servers on March 5th.
 - The Extraordinary Ministers will have a choice of attending a meeting on March 6th or 7th at 6:00 pm in the Church. This training will qualify for Archdiocese Qualification.
- Reports from Fundraising Committees: No report this month.

New Business:

- Father Casey reviewed the demographics for the Parish Canonical Boundaries.
- Father Casey is interested in bringing back a Booster Club. Our campus has much land that contains opportunities for sports programs to be created on the campus. Various names of parishioners who could re-invigorate a Booster Club to bring fellowship through Sports were discussed.
- Father Casey spoke of the upcoming plans for the Town Hall Meeting planned for Thursday May 30th at 6:30 pm to be held in the Community Center. Subjects for the Town Hall will be State of Parish finances, school, boosters, and an allotted time for questions from parishioners.
- Father Casey is asking the Parish Council for ideas of how to cut expenses so that the parish can live within the budget. Frank Hulsman has suggested that lights owned by LG&E be returned to them, the parish to purchase lights allowing us to pay only for the electricity and not a monthly rental fee. An energy audit by LG&E has been requested & member Maria Frank will request this audit. The new unit to be put into the Community Center should reduce expense for the AC and Heat.

- Father Casey is interested in creating Discipleship groups for Men and Women in the Parish. The Walking with Purpose Group Women's Bible Study group was mentioned as being active for the last 4 years.
- Father Casey would like to see if a Rosery Making Group could be created.
- Super Bowl Squares sold well, and a good time was had by all attending the Super Bowl Party.
- The Parish Super Raffel sales have begun.
- There was discussion about a safety concern on campus whereby many leaving the church grounds use the entrance and not the exit. Signage changes will be researched.
- Parish Life Committee chair and Right to Life Committee chair were tables for the next meeting.
- An Easter egg hunt after the 10:30 mass or between the masses will be considered for this year. Ashley Curry will reach out to Chris Clements.
