New Business:

- Lectio Divino was prayed using the Sunday Gospel of Mark 1:29-39 to begin the meeting. Parish Council Members were encouraged by Father to reflect on the state of the parish.
- Father Casey wishes to promote discipleship and be Christ centered in all that we do. He wishes to use events to evangelize.

- Father Casey wishes to promote the Catholic identity of the school. His vision is that through Mary we meet Jesus, and we make him LOVE.
- Elaine suggested that a Town Hall meeting be held to emphasize the relationship between the school and parish.
- Kathy Huber brought up a before and after school care program for free given your continued tithe of time, talent and treasure.
- The Council is currently reviewing bringing back Religious Education for those children not at the Academy.
- For Lent the Stations of the Cross will be on Fridays before the Fish Fry. The Stations had been held on Wednesdays in years past.
- This is the year of the Eucharistic Revival. Our parish has Eucharistic Adoration after the 8:00 am mass on Fridays for one hour now. Father would like to do it more frequently and extend it later for the parish. Formation on the Eucharist will be available for parishioners during Lent.
- The Parish is hosting several sessions for learning and sharing more about the Eucharistic during this year of the Eucharistic Revival.
- Last year only one hundred parishioners returned the Stewardship Forms. Father will contact Kathy DeLozier about this year's plan for stewardship.
- There will be a change as to how collections are made at mass. Beginning soon the baskets will be spread from pew to pew. The coordination to this change are being coordinated.
- Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion will be expected to attend one of two trainings held on March 6 & 7. The trainings will be in the Worship Center and conducted by Father Casey. Any current Ministers are expected to be present at one of the trainings. Father Casey will provide the training. Ther training sessions Father is offering will allow any current Extraordinary Ministers to apply for the mandate. The mandate is which is the card provided by the Archdiocese.
- The date for the Arts & Craft Fair has been set for October 19th, 2024.
- The school is hosting a Cultural Night on March 2nd.
- Boy Scouts will be having the Gumbo Dinner in the Community Center after the 4:30 Mass on Saturday.
- The 2nd Annual Super Bowl party is being held in the Parish Life Center (PLC) on February 11th. Father Casey hopes to use this event to Evangelize.
